Prize Money Levels and Conditions

By popular request we have re-instated prize money for 2023/4. There will be prizes for the top three and the best Silver and Bronze players. The way prize money is calculated has changed. The tables below show the actual prize money that will be awarded subject to a minimum size of competition being achieved. The full details are shown below.

Conditions:

- Subject to there being 20 Tables, below 20 prize money will be reduced pro rata
- The largest prize will always be awarded (eg a silver pair/team coming second will win the prize for 2nd and the next silver pair/team will win the silver prize).
- Silver Prize will only be awarded for a finish in the top half of the field.
- Bronze prize will only be awarded for a finish in the top $\frac{3}{4}$ of the field.
- In a pairs competition, the rank will be determined by the player with the higher rank
- In a teams competition the rank will be determined by the rank of the second highest player.
- Prizes will be paid by bank transfer to the person who registered for the event. Prizes for BBO competitions will be paid in BBO\$ direct to each player's account.
