Balanced Hands & Transfers

- Partner has opened 1NT. What do you bid as responder with these 1 hands?

- 2♥ Transfer to spades planning to rebid 3♣ to show your unbalanced shape & $game\ HCP\ 13\ +12\ =\ 25$

- 2♦ Transfer to hearts planning to Pass 8 + 12 = 20

2 NT with 11 HCP Partner is invited to bid 3NT if he Has 14 HCP ★ A84★ A952★ QT65

3 NT – you have enough Points to go to game and no 4 card major ♥ 8♦ A 8 7♣ K 8 7

Start with 2♥- a transfer to Spades. When partner completes the transfer you bid 4♠. You have enough for game.

4 What is the difference between a Natural and a Conventional bid?

A natural bid represents the suit bid whereas a conventional bid says nothing about the suit bid but instead carries a special meaning. Your partnership must have **agreed** to play that convention. The bid must be alerted by the **bidder's partner**. An opponent is entitled to ask what the convention means but only when it is that opponent's turn to bid or at the end of the auction once the opening lead has been put face down on the table.

3♥ Your bidding has described the shape of your hand 5: 4 in spades and hearts and is game forcing

3♦ Your first bid showed your 5 card spade suit. Your rebid shows your 4+ cards in your second suit diamonds. c) ★ AQT65

♦ A78

♣ J96

2NT Your first bid showed your 5 card spade suit. Your rebid shows invitational 10-12 HCP d) A A K 7 5 4 3

♥ Q65

♦ KT

♣ Q4

A Your first bid showed your 5 card spade suit. Your rebid shows game HCP and a 6 card spade suit. Opener for his 1NT bid must have at least 2 spades – you have a known fit

- e) ♠ J9763

Pass Your first bid showed your 5 card spade suit. You have only 5 HCPs – you want to' escape' from 1NT!

No game possible

3NT Your first bid showed your 5 card spade suit. Your rebid to game in NTs shows your HCPs and gives opener the option to convert to 4.

g) **♠** AKJT9

2NT Your first bid showed your 5 card spade suit. Your rebid shows your balanced shape and HCP count — inviting game if opener maximum. Opener can Pass if minimum; choose hearts for part score or game or raise to 3NT depending upon his hand

- 6 Partner opens 1NT. Responder's Right hand opponent bids 2♠ What is your bidding plan holding these THREE hands
- a) KJ982
 - **♥** 52
 - **♦** 93
 - **♣** J752

- b) **4 9**
 - **♥** KQ9842
 - ◆ A K 9
 - ♣ A 4

- c) 🖈 -
 - **♥** K84
 - ♦ AKJ986
 - ***** 752

- Pass! You are delighted to escape a 1NT contract plus, now very happy to defend 24!
- 4♥ You have 16 HCP.

 Opener to bid 1NT must have at least 2 hearts you have a suit fit and enough HCP for game so bid it!

Remember you do not use conventional bids if the opponents make an interference bid!

3 ♦ you have no defence to 2 ♠. Opener must have at least 2 cards in diamonds. Your side has the majority of HCP.

Remember you do not use conventional bids if the opponents make an interference bid!

Responder's 3NT rebid shows he has a 5 card heart suit and sufficient HCP to bid to game.

With a weak diamond suit and a fit in hearts you can choose to play in 4♥

Pass

Responder's 3NT bid shows he has a 5 card heart suit and sufficient HCP to bid to game.

With only 2 cards in hearts you do not have a fit so Opener is happy to play in 3NT

8 Your partner opens 1NT. What do you as Responder bid with the following? RHO passes.

- a) **★ KT9654**
 - **♥** A73
 - **9**
 - ♣ AQ5


- b) AT8432
 - **♥** 7632
 - ◆ T9
 - ♣ J

Bid 2♥ on both hands – this TELLS your partner he MUST bid 2♠.

Responder has enough HCP for game & knows partner must have at least 2 Spades to open 1NT so bid 4 on your next bid

Responder is very weak but Spades is a better contract than NT so 'escape' to a suit contract!

9 The bidding has gone as follows (1NT from your partner Opener, 2♦ from you responder). What is your second bid with the following hands?



10 What do you, Responder bid on the following if the bidding goes 1 NT, followed by a 2♠ from your RHO?

After an intervening bid from the opponents, all those conventional bids we have been talking about are OFF and any bid from you is now natural.

Pass

4 ♥ – you have enough HCP for Game and you know partner must have At least 2 Hearts.

Remember: Once you agree to play Stayman and Transfers after a NT opening by partner, all suit bids by Responder are Conventional Bids.

The only exception is if the opponents make an intervening bid in which case Conventional Bids are NOT used and responder bids naturally!
