A3. 1st - partner is asking you to bid your 'best' suit, give preference to a major.

2nd - bid NT with a STOP in opponents suit.

3rd - bid a minor

A6. Double. Ideal hand. 14 HCP and support in all other suits

A5. 0 - 7 Bid own 4+ card suit OR 1NT with no biddable suit and a stop in Opener's suit.
8 - 12 Jump in a 4+ card suit OR 2NT with a stop in Opener's suit
13+ Jump to game in a 5+ card suit OR 3NT with a stop in Opener's suit

A8.

- 1) 2* nil HCP, bid at lowest level possible
- 2) 1♠ Bid your best suit
- 3) 2♠ 8+ HCP, jump bid
- 4) 4♠ bid game. 12 HCP and6 good spades

A7. 1♥. No point in a takeout double when you can overcall. Cannot X with fewer than 3+ cards in ♠ or ♣ but can overcall with a 5-card suit.
