1) Pass - not strong enough to bid
2) 4 - -13 HCP and a good 5 card suit
3) $2 \boldsymbol{A}-8 \mathrm{HCP}$, bid a major over a minor

A1.
Shortage in the opponents suit Opening hand (12+ HCP)
Support - at least 3 cards in each of the unbid suits

A3. 1st - partner is asking you to bid your 'best' suit, give preference to a major.
2nd - bid NT with a STOP in opponents suit.
3rd - bid a minor

A5. 0-7 Bid own 4+ card suit OR 1NT with no biddable suit and a stop in Opener's suit.
8-12 Jump in a 4+ card suit OR 2NT with a stop in Opener's suit $13+$ Jump to game in a $5+$ card suit OR 3NT with a stop in Opener's suit
