

- **Q1** West leads the ♥2. What does East play?
  - **♥** 54

North

**♥** 2 **♥** Q 9 6

West East

- A1 East must put on the Queen Third hand plays high
- **Q2** West leads the ♥2. What does East play?

♥ J 5 4

North

**♥ 2 ♥ Q T 6** West East

- A2 Third hand plays high but only as high as is needed. Play the ♥T
- Q3 Playing in a suit contract, West leads the ♥2. What does East play?

♥ J 5 4

North

**♥2 ♥** K T 7

West East

**A3** West must have the Queen. He has led a small card promising an honour in the suit. You can see the K and J. Partner, would not have led the suit if he had the Ace (never lead away from the A in a suit contract!), so he must have the Queen. Play the 10 and keep the King to capture the Jack in dummy.

**Q4** West leads the ♥2. What does East play?

**9**654

**♥ 2 ♥ K Q 3** 

West East

- A4 Play the ♥Q. Partner will know that you could have the King as well.
- **Q5** South leads the ♥4. What should West play?

♥ A82

North

**♥** K 7 5 3

West

- A5 A low heart. Second hand plays low
- **Q6** South leads the ♥5. What should West play?

♥ A872

North

♥ QJ43

West

- A6 Small heart. No point putting on an honour. The Ace will be played from dummy anyway. Remember you have a partner. **Second hand plays low**
- **Q7** South plays the ♥Q. What should West play?

**♥** 54

North

**♥** K 6 4 3

West

A 7 ♥K. Cover an honour with an honour. You can't see it, but partner (East) might have the ♥T which would be promoted.

Q8 North (dummy) leads the ♥ J. What should East do?

▼ J 7North (dummy)▼ K 6 4 3East

**A8** Play low. Cover an honour with an honour **but only when there is a possibility of a card being promoted** for your side.

**Q9** What is your opening lead against 4♠ by South holding this hand?

- **♠**874
- **♥** T 6
- **♦ AK72**
- ♣ KJ54

**A9** ♦A – top of 2 touching honours
