## 3NT

You have stops in all three outside suits and hope to make 6 if not 7 diamond tricks plus 2 spades, 1 heart and possibly 1 or 2 clubs - all depending upon the lead. Your partner's bid promises at least 2 honours in the suit. (Better than $5 \diamond$ when you have stops in the outside suits

## A8

East bid a Double Jump Overcall. This shows a weak hand (6-10 HCP) and a good* 7 card suit in spades.
Remember if East bids $1 \boldsymbol{A}$ this is a simple overcall showing 8+ HCP and a good* 5 card suit. While a single jump bid of $2 \boldsymbol{4}$ shows a $\underline{6}$ card suit.

A pre-emptive 3 Level Bid shows a good* 7 card suit with 6-10 HCP A pre-emptive 4 Level Bid shows a good* 8 card suit with 6-10 HCP NB good* suit has 2+honours in the suit.
