

- 1. What do these terms mean?
- a) An Overcall: A bid made after the opponents have opened the bidding. Must be a good 5 card suit i.e. meet SQOT
- b) The SQOT: Suit Quality Overcall Test used to judge the quality of a 5 card overcall suit i.e. the number of cards + number of honours in the suit must equate to the number of tricks need to make.
- c) The Unassuming Cue Bid: A bid of the suit made by the opposition at the lowest level by Advancer asking partner, Overcaller, "How good is your overcall?" Used with support for overcall suit and 10+ HCP. UCB is not a natural bid. Must be alerted.
- d) Level of fit: Add together the total number of cards in the overcall suit between both hands and bid to the level of tricks this equates to e.g. 9 cards combined = 3 level bid.
- e) Who is Advancer and who is Responder? *Advancer is partner to Overcaller and Responder is partner to Opener.*

2. RHO opens 1. Should you bid, and if so what, with these hands?

3. RHO opens 1. Should you bid, and if so what, with these hands?

PASS: Your 5 card suit is in opener's suit!

**2**♦: 5 card suit, meets SQOT

2\*: 5 card suit meets SQOT

4. Your RHO opens 1♥. You are next to bid. Bid. What do you bid with the hands below?

Overcall 1. 5 card suit meets SQOT - 9HCP

- a) ♠6 5 2 ♥6 2. ♦A K J 7 5 4. ♣A 9
  2♦: 6 card suit meets SQOT
- b)  $\bullet$ Q 2  $\bullet$ K J 6 5 4  $\bullet$ Q J 7 5.  $\bullet$ A 7

  PASS: Your 5 card suit is in opener's suit!
- 5) The auction so far is 1\* -1\*- P ?

(Note: partner has overcalled 1♠ so you are Advancer)

Below are 5 examples of Advancer's hands. Advancer's options are to Pass, bid to the level of fit, or use the UCB. What should Advancer bid if holding these hand?

- a) ♠KJ52 ♥AJ3 ♠KQ74 ♣96
  2♣ UCB Bid of the opponent's suit asks Overcaller to rebid 2♠ if weak and game is strong.
- b) ♠A 5 2 ♥Q 6 2 ◆J 7 6 5 4 ♣9 7
   2♠ Support with 3 cards (3 + 5 = 8) You have a fit.
- c) ◆5 2 ▼K 6 2 ◆9 7 5 4 ◆A Q 9 7 PASS. No fit. Better to defend!
- d) ♠QJ2 ♥K6 ♠A KT85 ♣976
   2♣ UCB. Bid of the opponent's suit asks Overcaller to rebid 2♠ if weak and game is strong

PASS. Lead your ♠5 Hope partner reads this as promising an honour, and that he wins trick and leads back a small spade for you to ruff!

6) Here is another auction.

As Advancer, what do you bid with the example Advancer hands below?

- a) ♦KJ952 ♥Q2 ◆85 ♣9852
  - *3*♣ Bid to the level of fit!
- b) ♠A 5 2 ♥A Q J 2. ◆3 2 ♣J 8 5 4
  - 3. Support to the level of fit. (4 + 5 = 9)
- c) ♠KJ2 ♥A962. ◆AJT. ♣Q75

3NT Balanced hand 15 HCP & stops in all suits

- d) ♠KJ95 ♥KQJ982 ◆2 ♣T5
  - **2♥ You have a** good 6 card suit of your own.
- e) ♠7 ♥AKQ3 ◆A43 ♣QJ765
  - 5♣ Bid to game to keep opponents out of auction! They are quite likely to have spade fit but if they bid onto 5♦ they are likely to go down!!

7) As Advancer, what do you bid in the auction below?

Your partner has overcalled 2◆

Here is your hand as Advancer:

8) As Advancer, what do you bid in the auction below? Your partner has overcalled 1.

Here is your hand as Advancer:

4 $\spadesuit$  You have a fit (5 + 5 = 10), 16 HCP. If Overcaller has AK of spades only 3 losers!

9) As Advancer, what do you bid in the auction below? Your partner has overcalled 2\*

Here is your hand as Advancer:

PASS – with 11 HCP and with no fit it's often better to defend!

10) Partner opens 1♦, RHO overcalls 1♠.

As Responder, what do you bid with these hands?

2\* You were planning to respond 2\* You still can.

- b) ♦9 8. ♥K Q J 7 2 ♦6 5 4. ♣A 6 3
  2♥ Planning to respond 1♥ but with 10 HCP and 5 cards in hearts can bid 2♥
- c) ♠8 7 5 ♥K J 4 2. ♠T 6 4 ♣A 9 3

  PASS Planning to respond 1♥ cannot bid NT with no stop in spades must pass.
- d) ♠A J T 7 3 ♥A 5 4. ♦6 ♣J T 9 2

  PASS No fit with partner but 5 cards in opponent's suit!
- 11) Partner opens 1♥, RHO overcalls 1♠
  1♥- 1♠ -?

As Responder, what do you bid with these hands?

- a) ♦A T 7 2. ♥6 3 ◆J 9 5 ♣A Q T 8

  2NT bid by responder shows 10-12HCP with a ♦ stopper.
- b) ♠Q J 6 2 ♥A 8 4 ◆K T 7 ♣K J 9

  3NT With stops in the overcall suit and opening points also respond by bidding to game!
- c) ♠K 6 2 ♥K Q 5 3 ◆J 9 6 4 ♣Q 7

  3♥ You were planning to respond 3♥ You still can.
- d) ♦A T 4 3 ♥Q 6 ♦A 9 5 2 ♣J 8 7

  2♦ Planning to respond 1♦ but with11 HCP can now respond 2♦

12) Partner opens 1♥ and RHO overcalls 1♠.

As Responder, what would you bid with these hands?

- a) ♠7 4 ♥A Q 3 ♠T 9 4 3 ♣Q 9 5 2

  PASS /2♥ 8 HCP, 3 card support can Pass. BUT, with good honours in partner's suit can make a minimum raise even with only 3 card support!
- b) ♦9 5 4 3 ♥K 6 5 2 ◆3 ♣A 5 4 3

  3♥ 7 HCP but you have a fit. Singleton gives ruffing potential. 8 Losers on
- c) ◆5 2 ▼KJT83 ◆K9652 ◆4
   4♥ 7 HCP but you have a fit. 7 losers on LTC with a good shape for ruffing so bid game

LTC so stretch to 3 level to make it difficult for opponents!

- d) ♠K 7 3 ♥Q T 5 4 ◆K 5 ♣Q J T 2

  4♥ 11 HCP but you have a fit and hold good intermediary cards so worth a game bid
- e) ♦A 9 5 3 ♥A J 9 5 ◆K 7 5 2 ♣3

  4♥ You have opening points and a fit bid game!

13) Looking at the bidding auction below. What do you bid as Overcaller after partner (Advancer) has made an UCB?

- a) ♦AQJ986 ♥- ♦AJT4 ♣985
  - **4♠** Although only 12 HCP with this shapely hand Overcaller upgrades to bid game.
- b) **♦**KQJ43 **♥**8 **♦**KQ73 **♣**A97
  - 4 Advancer's bid shows a suit 'fit' and a strong raise by making and UCB.

    Overcaller has extra strengths to bid onto game.
- c) ♠KQJ43 ♥84 ◆Q73 ♣987
  - 2 Overcaller has a minimum hand, sees no game prospect so rebids his suit at minimum level.
