Examples of a 2NT opener

 ▲ K102 ♥ AJ43 ♦ KQ5 ♣ AKJ 	 ▲ A5 ▼ AQ4 ◆ QJ985 ▲ AK4 	 ▲ KQ94 ♥ QJ84 ◆ AK ▲ AKQ
3+5+5+8 = 21HCP	4+6+3+7 = 20HCP	5+3+7+9 = 24HCP (too strong) This one opens $2 \clubsuit$ - see Lesson 28

Avoid minors when partner opens in no-trump and you have no singleton

East bids 3NT – an easy 9 tricks (If the long suit is a major he transfers) 11 tricks are most unlikely

Responding to the Opening Bid of 2NT

	At least 25HCP, at least 8 spades You want to play in 4♠ Bid 3♥, transfer. Raise partner's 3♠ to game (Or just bid 4♠)	At least 27HCP, balanced You want to play in 3NT Bid 3NT!	At least 27HCP Use Stayman to look for a 4-4 major fit. If partner bids a major raise to game If he bids 3 ◆ - bid 3NT

The 3-level responses to 2NT are the same as the 2-level responses to 1NT – just one level higher.

Examples of bidding after a 2NT opener

Disappointing for West, but 2NT is quite high enough!

Stayman finds the 4-4 major fit Note that 3NT fails on a diamond lead

East's 3. promises a 4-card major, but there is no 4-4 fit



East should not worry about his to singleton. 4. would show slam interest He offers a choice between 3NT and 4.



With 34-36 points between the hands East settles in the small slam



East must have a 4-card major use Stayman so West converts to 4.



East might like to make a weak takeout into diamonds, but there is no such bid.



▲ AQ **▲** K9872 Ν ♥ KQ72 ♥ AJ85 W E • 74 ♦ KJ62 S ***** 32 ♣ KOJ West East 2NT 3• 3♠ 4**v**

There are not enough points for slam No point in bidding a minor, so East simply raises to 3NT

With both majors East transfers to ♠s, then bids ♥s. West chooses ♥s.
