

1) How should you tackle these spade suits in a no-trump contract?








2 cards for 1st trick:

2 cards for 2nd trick




You play in 1NT as West.

North leads ♣Q, you play ♣2 from dummy, South plays ♣A To trick 2 South leads a small club to your king

Which is your Work Suit?

How do you play it?



You play in 4♠ as West. North leads ♥J

You try ♥Q in case North has ♥K, but South produces ♥K. You win the trick with ♥A and begin to draw trump.


On ♠A North plays ♠10, dummy ♠2 and South ♠4

On ♠K North discards ♥2, dummy plays ♠5 and South ♠9

South has one trump left, the queen

Which is your Work Suit?

Which card should you play at trick 4?



You play in 3NT as West.

North leads $\clubsuit4$, you play $\clubsuit2$ from dummy, South wins the trick with $\clubsuit K$. To trick 2 South returns a small spade which you take in hand with $\clubsuit Q$

- a) You correctly played ♠2 at trick 1
 What danger was there if you played ♠A from dummy?
- b) What should you lead from the West hand to trick 3?
