



## **Hands for Lesson 20**




Lead: ♠K.

Finesse in trump and play to AQ




Lead: ♥A

Then K. North ruffs and finesses trump



Lead: ♦K.

Win at once, (109x is a second stopper). Tackle clubs By finessing.




Lead: ♠A

S must bid his best suit, as requested.




## Hands for Lesson 20



Lead: ♥10 (partner's suit).

East should not double here since West is likely to bid spades – you need at least 3 cards in any unbid majors




All Pass

Lead: ♦K.


West's clubs are far too poor for a 2 level overcall But a takeout double is fine. On the next round, pass Is best with only 3 cards in Spades,

South should rough a club in dummy before drawing All the trump



Lead: ♥2.

Prefer an overcall to a double when you have a good suit



WestNorthEastSouthPassPass1 ♠DblePass3 ♣Pass5 ♣

Lead: ♠A.

Since North is forced to bid even with nothing, they should jump to show a decent hand. South has 5 card support and slightly better than a minimum Double, so bids game
