When you are **Responder** and partner has opened **1of a suit** count your HCPs 0-5 HCPs – Pass.

With 6+ HCPs YOU MUST BID!

Priorities in Responding:

- 1. Support partner's bid major with a 'suit fit' at the correct level to show your HCPs
- 2. Bid a new suit of your own at the 1 level if you can
- 3. With 6-9 HCPs, no suit fit, and unable to bid a new suit **Bid 1NT** as last resort!
- **4.** If the **opponents bid a suit overcall**, a **Negative X** shows no fit with partner's suit but 4 cards in the other 2 unbid suits!

Count your HCPs – which group do they fall into?

6-9 HCPs Minimum hand

1. Bid **2 of major** with a fit With no fit in partner's suit;

- 2. Bid a **new suit** at the 1 level or
- 3. Bid **1NT** as last resort!

10-12 HCPs Invitational hand

- 1. Jump a level to bid **3 of major** with a fit
- 2. Bid a new suit of your own at **1 level** (or 2 level if you must)

13+ HCPs –a Game going hand

- 1. Bid to game in major with a
 - suit fit 4♥/♠
- 2. Bid your own suit at the **1 level** (or 2 level if you must)
