





Lead: ♦A.

East discourages. West switches to clubs


Lead: ♦A

West <u>discourages</u>, reverts to spades when he wins **A** 






South encourages to get his ruff.




#### Lead: &A.

East discourages, hoping for a diamond switch




### Lead: ♦Q.

*North <u>discourages</u>. When East draws trump, North discards the* ♥8 *to ensure a club switch.* 



Lead ♣K.

West encourages holding a doubleton club. When East later wins A, he continues clubs and West gets a ruff. In the fullness of time West wins  $\forall K$  for down



### Lead: &Q.

North encourages with the  $\clubsuit 5$ . Their lowest club. Then South knows it is safe to continue clubs when in with the trump Ace
