

Mini Bridge 22

Mini bridge 22 has involved the participation of fewer groups this year, but for those who did take part it has been no less exciting.

Only 2 Highland schools took part, but we had 50 children from Balloch Primary school in P7 and 27 from Avoch Primary in P6 both groups being taught in curriculum time. We benefitted greatly from Highland Council policy of supplying chrome books to all children.

This year, due to ongoing collaboration on education material with members of the 5 nations working group set up to get more youngsters playing Bridge, we invited all children in the British Isles learning mini bridge and two London Schools, Brookfield Primary School and Coldfall Primary took part and the geographic spread enriched the competition.
