

Double (X) This shows East has a **S**hortage in the pre-empt suit - Clubs, **O**pening points and **S**upport for the three other suits. **S.O.S**

b) You are West. What do you bid after the following auction?

4♠ - West has good shape and bids his longest suit, knowing that partner's X shows at least three card support, Opening points and Shortage in Clubs!
