OVERCALLS- General style: *Natural*.

Responses *other suit: forcing except 2/1,*

Jump: nat + fit, Cue = force.

IN THE REOPENING POSITION: 7-15H

Responses *cue-bid forcing*

TAKE-OUT DOUBLE - General style: 12⁺H except two suiter

Responses : *cue-bid forcing, jump 8-10; 1NT 7-10*

IN THE REOPENING POSITION 8⁺H

Responses *cue-bid forcing*

1NT OVERCALL 2nd pos. 15-18, Stayman, Texas.
4th pos: 10-14, Stayman, Texas.

JUMP OVERCALL: *Weak*
