Note 1	1 Major -2NT		Shows 4 card raise to at least 3 of the Major
		Responses	3 suit Cue bid (first or second round control) 3M minimum Subsequent bid of 3NT by either hand is a serious slam try
Note 2	Puppet Stayman responses to 1NT	Bid 2C	2H/2S shows 5 H/S 2D shows at least one 4 card major, then 2H by responder shows Spades and 2S shows H. Forcing to at least 2NT
Note 3	Transfers over 1NT	To a major	Opener breaks transfer to a major with 4 card support as follows:- With minimum to 3M. With maximum to a doubleton or to 3NT if 4333 shape.
		To a minor	2S is a transfer to C which opener can break to 2NT with 3 or more C to an honour. 2NT is a transfer to D which opener can break to 3C with 3 or more D to an honour. Transfer is not necessarily invitational.

			3D 5-7 HCP with at least two of the top three honours
