GENERAL DESCRIPTION OF SYSTEM

Bidding Methods:- 12-14 NT, 4 CM & 3 Weak 2's

Style of leads, signals, discards:- Top of sequence, 4th and 2nd (MUD) Carding: Standard Count (Hi-Lo = Even)

Discards: Discouraging suit

ASPECTS OF SYSTEM WHICH OPONENTS SHOULD NOTE

ACOL

STRENGTH OF 1NT OPENERS: 12-14

2♣ RESPONSE TO 1NT OPENER IS: Stayman
