## **GENERAL DESCRIPTION OF SYSTEM**

Bidding Methods:- Weak NT, 5 card majors, three weak twos, 2/1 forcing, clubs can be as few as 2

Style of leads, signals, discards:- Reverse attitude

## ASPECTS OF SYSTEM WHICH OPPONENTS SHOULD NOTE

No transfers.

1♣ shows 2 or more clubs.

Intermediate (i.e. opening values) jump overcalls.

1NT – X – XX is SOS, asking declarer to bid a 5 or good 4-card suit

STRENGTH OF 1NT OPENERS: 12-14 (11-15 in protected position)

2♣ RESPONSE TO 1NT OPENER IS: Stayman

Both players of a partnership must have identically completed convention cards.
