## GENERAL DESCRIPTION OF SYSTEM

**Bidding Methods: 12-14 NT with weak 2's in both majors. Benji.**

**2C = 8 playing tricks or 19/20 balanced**

**2D = 23+HCP or 9 playing tricks**

Style of leads, signals, discards: - Top of sequence, 4<sup>th</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> (M.U.D)  
First discard = high discouraging

Signals used- Reverse Attitude when possible.

## ASPECTS OF SYSTEM WHICH OPONENTS SHOULD NOTE

**2H and 2S opening bids are weak.**

STRENGTH OF 1NT OPENERS: 12-14

2♣ RESPONSE TO 1NT OPENER IS: Stayman
