### **GENERAL DESCRIPTION OF SYSTEM**

Bidding Methods:- Acol with 4-card majors, strong 2s

Style of leads, signals, discards:- 4<sup>th</sup> Highest from longest suit, top of a run, honour card of partner's bid suit. Standard signals. 1<sup>st</sup> discard is preferred suit if suit contract or non-preferred suit if in no trumps

## ASPECTS OF SYSTEM WHICH OPPONENTS SHOULD NOTE

Weak take outs over 1NT, strong 2s (8 playing tricks), usually gerber but sometimes blackwood

STRENGTH OF 1NT OPENERS: 12-14 popints

2. RESPONSE TO 1NT OPENER IS: weak take out

Both players of a partnership must have identically completed convention cards. Cards must be exchanged with opponents for each round.
