Bidding Methods: 12-14 NT with weak 2's in both majors. Benji.

2C = 8 playing tricks or 19/20 balanced

2D = 23+HCP or 9 playing tricks

Style of leads, signals, discards: - Top of sequence, 4th and 2nd (M.U.D)

First discard = high discouraging

Signals used- Reverse Attitude when possible.

ASPECTS OF SYSTEM WHICH OPPONENTS SHOULD NOTE

2H and 2S opening bids are weak.

STRENGTH OF 1NT OPENERS: 12-14

2♣ RESPONSE TO 1NT OPENER IS: Stayman

Both players of a partnership must have identically completed convention cards.

Cards must be exchanged with opponents for each round.
