### Jacoby

1H - 2NT (game raise in hearts)

Responses to 2NT response:

3H - slam interest

3NT - intermediate hand

4H - minimum opener

3C/3D/3S - shortage

4C/4D/4S - another 5 card suit, hence a shortage somewhere else.

### Multi Landy
