Ogust – 3C = min + poor; 3D = min + good, 3H = max + poor, 3S = max + good

Capelletti – 2C = both majors; 2D = single suit, 2H = hearts + minor, 2S = spades + minor, 2NT = both minors

DONT - X=5card suit, 2 of suit = lower of 2x4 card suits

Bergen Raises - 3C = 7-9; 3D = 10-11, 2NT = 12+ & no singleton or void (opener bids shape at 3 level and 2nd suit at 4 Level)
