After a 3C response 3 Dia asks for void or singleton.

Inverted Minor Response of 2NT shows minor suit opener to be a 3 card suit. Over 2Clubs 2Dia shows 4 + Clubs and no more than 15 hcp/2 hearts=16+ hcp and 4 + Clubs Over 2 Diam 2hearts shows 4+ Diam and no more than 15 hcp/2spades =16+hco and 4+ Diam.
