DEFENSIVE AND COMPETITIVE BIDDING
OVERCALLS (Style: Responses: 1 / 2 Level; Reopening)
Sound at 2 level
Occasionally 4 cards at 1 level
Jump raises are preemptive, new suit F1
If p overcalls in a major, cue=good 3crd raise, 2NT=good 4crd raise
If p overcalls in a minor, cue=good 3+crd raise, 2NT=Not
1NT OVERCALL (2nd/4th Live; Responses; Reopening)
Direct: 15-18, system on
Protective: 11-14, system on
Competition
After they x for penalty, xx=a suit (relay to 2C), 2X=44+ in that suit and a higher. Pass= to play
JUMP OVERCALLS (Style; Responses; Unusual NT)
Weak, 5-9, 6 card suit
Subsequent 2NT is an inv+ enquiry. Raises are preemptive.
Unusual 2NT: 55 in two lowest suits
Reopen: Jumps are 13-16, 2NT=18-21
DIRECT & JUMP CUE BIDS (Style; Response; Reopen)
Michaels, 55+ : 1m-2m = majors; 1M-2M= oM+m
(1M)-2M-p-2nt = inv+ enquiry as you can bid 3c p/c
(1x)-3x=stopper ask
VS. NT (vs. Strong/Weak; Reopening;PH)
X = Pen, 2C Majors, otherwise natural
After we double them for penalties, the next double is t/o and subsequent doubles are penalty.
VS.PREEMPTS (Doubles; Cue-bids; Jumps; NT Bids)
Dbl = T/O, Lebensohl applies over weak twos
VS. ARTIFICIAL STRONG OPENINGS- i.e. 1♣ or 2♣
X = Majors, NT = Minors
Use 1NT as UCB after partner overcalls.
