Bidding Methods:-
Strong club with 15-17 NT

Style of leads, signals, discards:-
Standard, reverse attitude on lead, revolving discards.

**ASPECTS OF SYSTEM WHICH
OPPONENTS SHOULD NOTE**

1 club is 16+ hcp
3 weak twos

STRENGTH OF 1NT OPENERS: 15-17

2♣ RESPONSE TO 1NT OPENER IS: stayman

Cards must be exchanged with opponents for each round.
