## Senior Camrose & Lady Milne Trial for 2022 – Supplementary Conditions of Contest

The trial for the Senior Camrose and Lady Milne in 2022, whether these events are face to face or online, will take place on Realbridge the weekend of December 4<sup>th</sup> & 5<sup>th</sup> 2021. **The closing date for entries is Sunday October 31<sup>st</sup> 2021.** 

Participants should ensure that they have adequate technical equipment to play on. Tablets are to be discouraged – decent sized laptops or PCs are much preferable. Video and microphones are required to be turned on at all times during play.

The trial will be organised as a Full Howell so that each pair plays every other pair entered. The number of boards played will be no more than 60 per day, so depending on the number of entrants, it may be necessary to play some on the Friday evening (Dec 3<sup>rd</sup>).

The scores for each match will be in X imps with a cap appropriate to the number of pairs and boards played. The 2 Senior Pairs and the 2 Women's Pairs with the highest VP scores at the end of the weekend will automatically be selected to represent Scotland in the Senior Camrose and Lady Milne respectively.

The choice of the 3<sup>rd</sup> pair for each event will be up to the International Committee using information available from the trial.

In line with the new BGB policy while matches are being played online, a 4<sup>th</sup> pair will also be identified to act as reserves.

**Convention cards** – These should be in WBF format and labelled as follows – Surname 1\_Surname 2\_21-22 where Surname 1 is the name of one person in the pair and Surname 2 the name of their partner. They should be converted into a pdf before being submitted but keep a copy in Word in case you are required to make any changes. These should be submitted to Mike McGinley (<u>mike.mcginley@zen.co.uk</u>) by November 6<sup>th</sup> at the latest so it can be checked by either Mike or Malcolm Cuthbertson to make sure all relevant information is included. They will then be posted on the SBU website.

**The entry fee is £25 per person.** If paying online, please use as a Reference either SCsurname or LMsurname – payment will be due by November 20<sup>th</sup> 2021.
