

GENERAL DESCRIPTION OF SYSTEM

Bidding Methods:- ACOL, 3 WEAK 2'S AND WEAK NT

Style of leads, signals, discards:-

**ASPECTS OF SYSTEM WHICH
OPONENTS SHOULD NOTE**

STRENGTH OF 1NT OPENERS: 12-14

2♣ RESPONSE TO 1NT OPENER IS: STAYMAN

Both players of a partnership must have identically completed convention cards.
Cards must be exchanged with opponents for each round.
