SUPPLEMENTARY DETAILS

(Please cross reference to appropriate part of card)

- .1 **Jacoby 2NT** FG (Limit Raise by an UnPassed hand)
3-level bids = Natural, Good hand
Now, 1) New suit by Responder = Shortage
2) 3NT by Responder = No shortage
- 2 **2NT (Strong Ask) over 2D**
3 minor = Max Weak 2 with corresponding Major (♣ = ♥, ♦ = ♠)
3 Major – min Weak 2
3♥♠ over 2D
PoC
- 3 **2NT (Strong Ask) over 2♥♠**
3 minor = min with this minor
3 Major – Max with corresponding minor (♥ = ♣C, ♠ = ♦)
- 4 **Muppet Stayman** 3♣ response to 2NT opening or 2NT rebid after 2♣ opening
Responses: 3♦ = No 5 card Major, At least one 4 card Major
4♣ = Slam Interest in both Majors
4♦ = No Slam Interest
3♥ = No 4+ card Major
3♠ = 5♠
3NT = 5♥ (Now, 4♦ = Transfer to 4♥)
- 5 **Multi-Landy ...** Over Opps 1NT **AND** Over Opps Short Club (0-2♣'s)
2♣ Both Majors (2♦ = Choose your Major)
2♦ Single-suited Major (2H = poC)
2♥♠ 5 Major & a 4+ minor

If Advancer bids:
- Raises of Major are Competitive (i.e. To Play)
- 3♦ = Invitational in Overcallers Major
- Any Club bid = POC

2NT from Advancer is always a Strong Ask;
- (1NT) 2 Major (P) 2NT / (P) 3 minor = min with that minor
- (1NT) 2 Major (P) 2NT / (P) 3 Major = good hand with corresponding minor.
- 6 **3 way Checkback** (Checkback over ALL 1NT rebids).
2♣ = Puppet to 2♦ - either to play or next bid = Inv
2♦ = G/F Checkback

GENERAL DESCRIPTION OF SYSTEM

Bidding Methods:-

ACOL, 12-14 NT, Lucas 2♥♠, Weak only Multi 2♦

Style of leads, signals, discards:-

Leads: 2nd/4th (10 NOT an honour)

Signals: Reverse Attitude, Standard Count;
SP (incl in trumps), Smith Peters v NT (Hi-Lo likes)

Discards: Reverse Attitude (1st discard, then Count or SP)

ASPECTS OF SYSTEM WHICH OPPONENTS SHOULD NOTE

STRENGTH OF 1NT OPENERS: 12-14 HCP

2♣ RESPONSE TO 1NT OPENER IS: Stayman (Non-Promissory)

Both players of a partnership must have identically completed convention cards.
Cards must be exchanged with opponents for each round.
