- 1 Response to P's overcall is level of fit, change of suit strong and no support, UCB strong + support of P's suit.
- 2 Responses to Jacoby 2NT
3 C/D/H/S singleton/void 3H/S !7+p and no sing/void 4C/D/H/S second 5card suit 4H/S minimum hand 12-14p
- 3 Bergen 4 card support for opener's major 3C=6-9p, 3D= 10-12, 3H/S=0-6
- 4 Ekren 2D showing 5/5 or 5/4 in both majors, Responder with 15+ 2NT, Opener 3C minimum, 3D 55 in majors, 3H max 5/4, 3S max 5/4,
- 5 Drury Responder is a past hand 2c = 3 card support 10-11, 2D 4card support 10-12



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GENERAL DESCRIPTION OF SYSTEM

Bidding Methods:- 5Card Majors, 2 ov1, 1nt 15-17, weak 2s in H and S, 2 D is Ekren*

Style of leads, signals, discards:-
Standard Leads.

Signals Mckenny, Odds and Evens and Reverse Attitude
Discards: Suit Odds and Evens, NT Reverse Attitude.
