Capelletti – 2C = both majors; 2D = single suit, 2H = hearts + minor, 2S = spades + minor, 2NT = both minors

DONT - X=5card suit, 2 of suit = lower of 2x4 card suits

Bergen Raises - 3C = 7-9; 3D = 10-11,
2NT = 12+ & no singleton or void (opener bids shape at 3 level
and 2nd suit at 4 Level)

1S 3H or 1H 2S = 3 cards & >9

Response of 3NT to major or minor opening is to play

FSF = forcing to game
