GENERAL DESCRIPTION OF SYSTEM

Bidding Methods:- 15-17NT, 5-cd majors, 3 weak 2's

Style of leads, signals, discards:- Standard attitude and count
McKenney discards, where poss

ASPECTS OF SYSTEM WHICH OPONENTS SHOULD NOTE

STRENGTH OF 1NT OPENERS: 15-17

2♣ RESPONSE TO 1NT OPENER IS: Stayman
