SUPPLEMENTARY DETAILS

1. Over 1H/1S, 2N shows good raise to 3 or 5+. Then 3Suit=Singleton, 4Suit=void, 3N=no shortage not after intervention			
3. Unopposed 1N, 2N = transfer to 3C, responder passes with C, bid 3D to play or 3 of major shows shortage in bid suit and 5-5 minors, FTG			
4. Over weak 2, change of suit forcing, except 2M over 2D at pairs, 2N enquiry, 3C = poor suit and count, 3D = Good suit, poor count, 3H = Good count poor suit, 3S = Good suit and count			
5. Michaels 2N = 2 lowest, Cue Major=other major+minor. Cue minor = majors			
6. 2C continuations: 2D=8+, 2H=0-3, 2S=4-7, 2N, 3C, 3D, 3H = Transfers showing decent 6 card Suit and 4-7 points
