OVERCALLS (Style: Responses: 1 / 2 Level; Reopening)
Natural – aggressive NV vs VUL otherwise sound : Good 4 card suit possible at 1 level but normally 5 cards
2 level overcalls expect 6 cards
Responses : Jump raise pre-emptive ; CB shows fit and values
Change of suit natural
1NT OVERCALL (2nd/4th Live; Responses; Reopening)
2 nd 15-18 system on
4 th 10-14 system on
JUMP OVERCALLS (Style; Responses; Unusual NT)
Weak Jump overcalls quality according to vulnerability
2NT – both minors 5-5 expected
Reopen: Intermediate
DIRECT & JUMP CUE BIDS (Style; Response; Reopen)

Checkback Stayman over 1x-1y – 1NT :2C INV and 2D GF
Also over 1x – 1y – 2NT : 3C is Checkback
