Bidding Methods:- Standard ACOL, 3 weak 2s

Style of leads, signals, discards:- standard leads, standard attitude, natural discards

ASPECTS OF SYSTEM WHICH OPPONENTS SHOULD NOTE

STRENGTH OF 1NT OPENERS: 12-14

2♣ RESPONSE TO 1NT OPENER IS: Stayman

Both players of a partnership must have identically completed convention cards.
Cards must be exchanged with opponents for each round.
