## Simple Overcalls at 1 or 2 level:

General Style: Competitive, 8+ HCP or 4+playing tricks at

1-level; 10+ or 5 playing tricks at 2-level. Responses: Natural, Raises pre-emptive

Cue-Bid Response: unassuming cue-bid, some support

#### 1NT overcall

Good 15-17 maybe 18 with stopper(s). Systems are 'On' (Stayman and Transfers) Systems are 'off' after any interference/double (i.e. all bids revert to natural)

## **Jump Overcalls**

Generally weak, Pre-emptive, 6+ card suit Double jump pre-emptive, 7+ card suit

### **Other Conventional Overcalls**

Unusual No-trump: 2 lowest ranking unbid suits Michaels Cue-Bid: 2-suited hand, any unbid majors

**Quantitative r**aise of NT to 4NT/5NT, (slam tries)

**Cue-Bidding** after suit agreement
