# The Hugh Kelsey Cup

1. All participants must be bona fide Learners, attending Classes for Beginners or Improvers - **not** regular Club players! Different Classes may combine to form a heat. Teachers are asked to indicate players who are genuine Novices – who have been learning for less than a year.
2. Since the same boards will be played, a Learner may participate once only.  
(We trust you not to pass on any information that might be useful to your friends....)
3. There will be set hands and a commentary booklet to be distributed at the end of play  
(The Organiser/Teacher will make the boards up in advance)
4. Each Novice Pair must play at least 10 of the boards – others at least 12 – to be eligible for major prizes
5. The minimum number of tables is 2. (Movements will be supplied for any number of tables)
6. Heats can be played any time during the week 19-23 March 2018 (morning, afternoon or evening)  
(If you wish to organise a heat during the week before please indicate below)
7. If you have access to scorebridge, please send the datfile and list of names under 18s and a list of names of first year learners. If your club does not have scorebridge access send a list of names and starting positions with U for under 18 and F for first year learners marked on it and travelers. Entry fees of either £2 per head if club/class print their own hand commentaries or £2.50 per head if commentaries supplied. **All fees to be sent within 3 days of the heat** to George Plant. Payment may be made on line ensuring that you state event -Kelsey and club/class.  
(Schools may run a heat, **Juniors are charged half price**)
8. Prizes will be awarded to heat winners and the leading pairs on the overall ranking list, best first year students and best under 18s
